Parking – Catlins Car Park in front of Town Hall. Parking for 40 cars + disabled bays. Pay and Display 30 mins costs 50p. 1 hour costs 70p

On foot - Town Hall accessed from the High Street through Baines Walk

Date

It is starting at the beginning of January 2021.

Patients will be informed of the date and time of their vaccination either by a text message service or a phone call. **Do not call your surgery.**

Please let your surgery know your mobile phone number if you have not done so already, if you have one.

Age Group to be seen first

The over 80 years patients will be called first.

Vaccination

Will be given in two parts – 1st vaccination on date you are called and 2nd vaccination 21 days later.

Both vaccinations are important to have – the first a kick start the immune system and the second to maximise the immune effect.

Both parts of the vaccination are important so please turn up for both.

You will be asked to stay on site for 15 minutes after the vaccination to make sure you have no ill effects.
