Question : I have been sent a text to ask to book but it must be wrong as I am fit and healthy, I do not want to take someone else's vaccination. Should I contact the surgery to cancel.

Answer: We all need a vaccination at some point, So NO, please do not contact the surgery as this will take up valuable care navigation or clinical time that could be used to help other patients with other non COVID-19 problems.

We are now 1/3 of the way through the Covid-19 vaccination programme and still have a long way to go. We thank every one of you for standing by us and helping us drive our COVID-19 vaccination Bus on our journey to a if not the same destination as before a better place than we are in now.

I would also like to thank all the surgery staff including Admin, Dispensary, Care navigation, Pharmacy and clinical team that without them this exit strategy would not be possible.

Also a big thank you to the PPG family that send teams of volunteers out in all weathers to help.

I would also request that any patients with any conditions they are worried about please do not put off coming to see the surgery team as we are still here and open for other conditions that are not COVID-19 related.
